ASSIGNMENT (Reflection Paper)

PURPOSE: This assignment is related to all the topics of Human Biochemistry. It is intended to understand the biochemical composition of life, different chemical reactions and the use of biomolecules in the cellular level and the body.

PROCEDURES & CONTENT Gather Data:

Write Your Report:

1. Select a title that reflects the importance of psychology to nursing.
2. Introduce the topic in the context of nursing and human biochemistry.
3. Make a formal or informal discussion about your topic
4. Make a conclusion

ASSIGNMENT FORMAT:

1. A paper about 2 - 4 pages long
2. The paper must contain the following sections:
 - Introduction
 - Discussion
 - Conclusion
 - References if there are any
3. Typed, double-spaced, with 1-inch margins
4. Proofread for spelling and grammatical errors – and indent paragraphs
5. Provide in-text citations and reference any sources using APA format

 - If someone who did not know much about the topic I am writing about, understand it better after reading my paper?
 - Do I have a backup copy saved?
