You will get the most out of the assignments if they are done while or shortly after we study a particular topic/chapter. Therefore, you will need to turn in your work by the deadlines designated in your syllabus and on the assignment sheet. No late assignments will be accepted.
- 4. All written assignments must be typed and double-spaced.
- 5. Please use APA rules of citation.
- 6. The deadline of submission is on 2 January 2023

HOW WILL YOUR ASSIGNMENTS BE GRADED

Each of your assignments is worth 100 points and will generally be graded by the following criteria:

- 1. Demonstration of critical thinking, scholarship, and ability to connect and apply the material
- 2. Comprehensiveness and completeness of your responses
- 3. Adherence to the written instructions
- 4. Spelling and grammar

ASSIGNMENT (Reflection Paper)

PURPOSE: This assignment is related to all the topics of Nursing Education. It is intended to understand and address the need of the students in relating to how they look at a model teacher and their qualifications so that they have something to adapt in the future.

Type/Length of activity: Informal or formal essay

PROCEDURES & CONTENT Gather Data:

Examine your lives and think of the most influential teacher(s) that affect(s) your lives. Identify their personal and professional qualities that made them exceptional teachers. Then make a reflection paper on why they became model teachers. Discuss the relevance of their teaching influence to your personal and professional life.

Write Your Report:

- 1. Select a title of your choice that reflects how to
- 2. to be an ideal teacher.
- 3. Introduce the topic in the context of Nursing Education.
- 4. Make a formal or informal discussion about your topic
- 5. Make a conclusion

ASSIGNMENT FORMAT:

- 1. A paper about 4 pages long
- 2. The paper must contain the following sections:
 - Introduction
 - Discussion
 - Conclusion
 - References if there is any
- 3. Typed, double spaced, with 1 inch margins
- 4. Proofread for spelling and grammatical errors and indent paragraphs
- 5. Provide in-text citations and reference any sources using APA format

Assignment Checklist

Before you turn in any written work, be sure you ask yourself the following:

When is it due?
Is it typed and double-spaced?
Did I answer all of the questions?
Are my answers complete and thorough?
Did I explain answers in my own words and avoid copying text from my textbook or other sources?
If I needed to take information directly from another source, did I use quotation marks and cite my source (including the textbook), by indicating the author, publication date, and page number?
When I provide my opinion, belief, or idea about something, did I also explain why and support my answer?
Is my work proofread and free from grammatical errors?
Do I understand what I wrote?
If someone who did not know much about the topic I am writing about, understand it better after reading my paper?
Do I have a backup copy saved?
